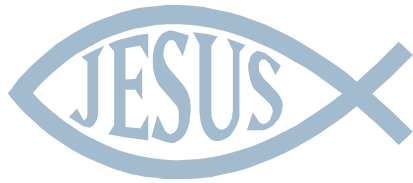


ARC Christian Camp Scholarship Brochure

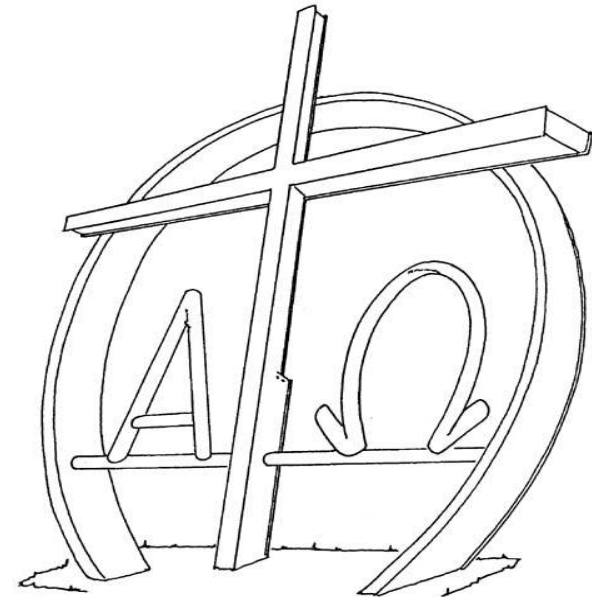
A quality Christian camp experience is life-changing! The Phil Featherstone Camp Scholarship Program can help those plugged into a church to come to camp.

Scholarship money is available on a "first-come-first-served" basis to those for whom cost is an obstacle to attending camp. The scholarship is provided **directly** to the camp and covers up to 50% of the cost of attendance. The following ARC camps are approved for 2008:

- *SIDE X SIDE* (grades 7-12) Feb. 1-3, 2008
- *Sno Daze* (grades 4-7) Feb. 1-3, 2008
- "Fire Up" Camp (grades 4-7) June 22-27, 2008
- *Kids: Camp* (Grades 1-3) June 27-29, 2008
- *Family Camp* July 20-26, 2008

Policy & Procedures:

Step 1: Pick up an application form or visit the ARC web site (www.arc-aflc.org) under "Resources," then under "Forms" Fill our application and complete scholarship guidelines (see next page) with ministry leader.

Step 2: Mail the completed and signed application form and a record of guidelines completed to the ARC.

Applications received after the deadline will not be considered.

Step 3: Completed applications will be reviewed by authorized representatives of the ARC. Once approved, scholarship payments will be paid to the approved camp in the name of that person or family.

Step 4: Parents will be notified in writing or by e-mail that the scholarship has been paid directly to the camp. If cancellation of camp is necessary, it must be done in writing or by e-mail.

ARC Camp Scholarship Church Guidelines

1. **Attendance-All ages**– Take part in at least 50% of all regularly scheduled church activities (Church, Sunday School, kids club or youth group).

2 Service:

Grades 1- 2: Three hours of service at home approved by the parent. Written description given to ministry leader for verification.

Grades 3-6: Five hours of verified service in one of the following:

- At home beyond normal house hold duties and chores, this does **not** include cleaning ones own room!
- Participation in the Adult Home Visitation Ministry or other Helping Ministry.*
- Other ARC special service projects approved by the ministry leader.*

***Must be accompanied by parent.**

Grades 7-12: Five hours of service in an AFLC or church body ministry. This must be verified by a parent or ministry leader.

3. **Memorization**-Memory work requirements are to be monitored during discipleship sessions with the ministry leader.

- Grades 1-2 Books of the New Testament, in order
- Grade 3-4 Books of Old Testament and New Testament in order
- Grade 5-6– All requirements for grades 1-4 plus Romans 3:23, Romans 5:8
- Grades 7-8– All requirements for grades 1-6 plus Romans 6:23, Romans 10:9
- Grades 9-12(and adults) All requirements for grades 1-8 plus, Romans 10:13, Matt 18:20,
